AGENDA DATE: 05/13/25

ACTION REQUESTED: Allow the Police Department to surplus the aforementioned vehicles.

BACKGROUND: Improving our police patrol vehicle fleet has been a long and challenging process. We have already seen the benefits of having a modern patrol vehicle with appropriate equipment. In the past, it was rare to be able to keep a patrol unit in-service for any significant amount of time before the next major failure.

One aspect of vehicle fleets that is usually an afterthought are back-up units. With the unpredictable nature of police work, coupled with regularly scheduled maintenance, we must also maintain a functional back-up fleet.

We have reached critical mass with our oldest patrol vehicle as well as our back-up units. Surplus two vehicles plus utilizing other funding from the police budget, we will unburden the fleet with non-patrol ready vehicles and add reliable units back to patrol.

RECOMMENDATION: Allow the Police Department to surplus the white Ford F-150 and the Black Ford Explorer to sell and in turn use those funds to purchase more reliable vehicles.

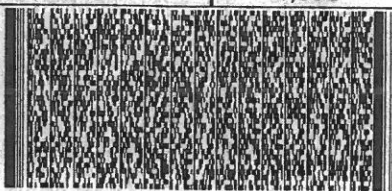
